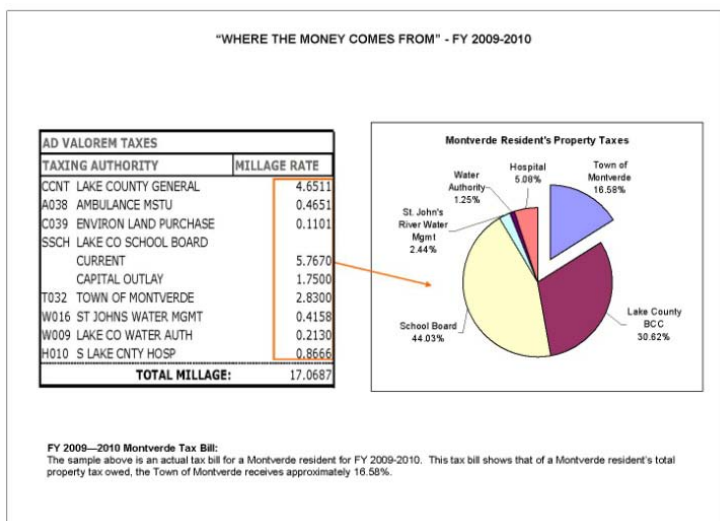
Montverde Day
