OTHER COVID-19 VIRUS NEWS

If you or one of your family members are experiencing symptoms that are consistent w/ COVID-19, please call your Dr. If you don't have a Dr. call the FL Dept of Health's Hotline at (352)742-4830. Please follow the CDC & FL Dept of Health guidelines to help reduce the spread of the virus. Those guidelines can be found at www.cdc.gov and floridahealthcovid19.gov. Lake County's health and public safety officials have implemented preparedness & response efforts to slow the spread of the virus. The hospitals & other health care facilities have enhanced the screening process & procedures to ensure the safety of patients and medical staff. The local hospitals' emergency departments are operating without delays or issues due to the virus, and they have added capacity & designated areas for COVID-19 patients, which will be available when needed. The FL Dept of Health is working w/Lake County residents who have been exposed to or are exhibiting symptoms of the virus. Local doctors' offices are providing testing for their patients and they are coordinating with the Health Dept to assist with administering their test kits. If your Dr. has any questions about whether an order can be written for you to be tested, please have them contact the Lake County Health Dept at (352)742-4830 to coordinate the testing.
