If the family has pets, it is recommended to keep pet supplies on hand to include: food, water, registration records, medications, proof of vaccination, leash and collar.

New Format for Utility Bills

Starting this month, the utility bills will now show water usage for the same month the previous year and the tiered rate structure.

<u>Reminder</u>: Bills are sent out on the first of each month and payment is due by the 20^{th} of the month. A late fee is assessed on the 21^{st} and accounts remaining unpaid after the 30^{th} will be disconnected and be subject to \$35 disconnect fee and a \$35 reconnect fee to reactivate service.
