# **FY 2015 BUDGET PRESENTED TO COUNCIL**

The budget for Fiscal Year 2015 was presented to Council on July 17, 2014. Mayor Troy Bennett presented the budget for next year reflecting total General Fund revenues of \$979,951 and total General Fund expenditures of \$835,766. This means that over \$144,000 will be added to the Town's Reserves (savings) and available for any necessary capital improvement projects.

The budget was presented with a property tax rate of 2.83 mils. This property tax rate has stayed the same since 2007, even with the downturn in the economy and the drastic reduction in home values. The Town has still been able to accomplish a lot of capital improvements without raising the tax rate. The FY 2015 proposed budget is detailed below. The entire budget is available for viewing at Town Hall.
