The Caucus provides the opportunity for a Town resident to nominate another Town resident to run for elected office. This year, three positions on Town Council are up for election and also the position of Mayor. The positions are for a two-year term, and require a significant investment of time.

Candidates must be registered voters and have resided in the Town for a period of six consecutive months prior to the date of the election caucus.
