UNLAWFUL ACTIVITIES

I propose:

- (Section a) "Every person who buries, or causes to be buried, a
 person in the town cemetery in a plot other than assigned to the
 deceased shall be guilty of violation of this chapter and, upon
 conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall be subject to a
 fine not to exceed \$500.00 or a term of imprisonment in the Lake
 County Jail not to exceed 30 days, or both fine and imprisonment"
 be deleted as it is repetitious.
- 2) (Section b) Change "town council" TO "town clerk" and delete the rest of the paragraph.

AMENDMENT TO READ

- a) It shall be unlawful for any person or legal entity to bury, or cause to be buried, a person in the town cemetery in a plot other than the plot assigned to the deceased. It shall be unlawful for any person or legal entity to bury a person in the town cemetery unless such a person or legal entity holds a certificate of interment issued by the town clerk or the mayor. Every person who buries, or causes to be buried, a person in the town cemetery without a certificate of interment shall be guilty of violation of this chapter and, upon conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or a term of imprisonment in the Lake County Jail not to exceed 30 days, or both fine and imprisonment.
- b) It shall be unlawful for any person or legal entity to place a gravestone, tombstone or any burial monument or any other marker including, but not limited to, trees and bushes in the town cemetery unless such a person or legal entity obtains written permission of the mayor or town clerk.
