

## **MESSAGE FROM MAYOR JOE**



A customer shall be allowed to exchange their garbage cart of recycling bin anytime if damaged. The customer will call **Waste Pro Customer Service at 352-366-0352** and request an exchange due to a damaged cart or bin. There is no charge for exchanging a damaged garbage cart or recycle bin. If the customer requests an exchange of a dirty cart or bin for a clean cart or bin, the customer will pay Waste Pro \$40.00 prior to delivery. Waste Pro shall deliver carts or bins within five (5) business days after the customer requests the exchange.



A longtime Montverde resident will pick up discarded Christmas trees to create mulch for the Town. Please put your Christmas Tree by the road the night before garbage collection and it will be collected.
