



DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY TOWN OF MONTVERDE

Whereas, a potential, serious threat to the public health, safety and welfare will be created by Hurricane Ian, predicted to begin striking Florida as early as Wednesday, September 28, 2022 with heavy rains and high winds impacting central Florida inclusive of the Town of Montverde.

Whereas, Florida State Statute, Chapter 252 and Sec. 2-21 of the Town of Montverde Code of Ordinances authorizes the Mayor of the Town of Montverde to declare that a local state of emergency exists.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED,


The Emergency Management Plan is activated and the town manager shall have the power, authority and preservation of health, safety and welfare of the citizens and property of the Town of Montverde.

All Town of Montverde assets are hereby ordered to be placed at the disposal of the town manager for emergency management.

All Town regulations prescribing procedures for the conduct of Town business, if strict compliance would hinder necessary action in coping with the emergency, are hereby suspended. Suspension of such procedures shall be at the direction of the town manager.


The town manager shall provide overall coordination of Town response.

In accordance with F.S.S. Chapter 252, this Declaration shall remain in effect for a period of seven (7) days unless extended or dissolved.
