#### \*\*NOTICE\*\* EXCHANGE OF GARBAGE CART & RECYCLE BIN \*\*NOTICE\*\*

Effective immediately, a customer shall be allowed to exchange their garbage cart of recycling bin anytime if damaged. The customer will call **Waste Pro Customer Service at 352-366-0352** and request an exchange due to a damaged cart or bin. There is no charge for exchanging a damaged garbage cart or recycle bin. If the customer requests an exchange of a dirty cart or bin for a clean cart or bin, the customer will pay Waste Pro \$40.00 prior to delivery. Waste Pro shall deliver carts or bins within five (5) business days after the customer requests the exchange.

#### YARD DEBRIS PROCEDURES

Place all garden and yard trash, includes tree & shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, & small branches either in a 32 gal trash can, commingled w/ garbage in the 96 gal container, or in a plastic bag. Shrubs, branches, limbs & palm fronds should not exceed 4 ft in length & must be bundled/tied. No single item can exceed 50 lbs. No more than 4 cans, bags or bundles may be set out for collection at one time. **Excessive amounts or bulk yard trash items:** If more than four cans, bags or tied bundles of yard trash need to be set out, or piles of heavy logs and/or stacks of wood fencing, please contact Waste Pro at **352-366-0352** to schedule a quote. Once payment is received, Waste Pro will schedule the the collection of excessive/bulk yard trash material.
