Water System Upgrade: Beginning in January, the Town will begin a project to update the water system in the Northeast part of Town. Outdated water pipes will be replaced in this area, primarily along Broad, Temple, and Strahan Streets. This project represents a direct re-investment of taxpayer dollars back into the Town.

New Bike Trail: As a recipient of the Recreational Trails Grant, the Town is pleased to announce that it will begin construction on an extensive bike trail thru Town that will connect Kirk Park to the newly-renovated Truskett Park. This project is primarily grant-funded, and construction will begin during the month of January.

REQUIREMENTS

- Provide proof that you served in the Armed forces. Copy of DD214, DD215, AGO, or a WD form is required.
- Provide proof that you live in Lake County. Voter's Registration is best.
- Submit copies of these documents to the office and we will enter you into our database.
