

Town Hall Happenings

Over the past few weeks, Town Hall has been reestablishing communication with the outside world. On June 10, a lightning storm caused several thousand dollars worth of damage to computers, switches, printers, and laptops when a bolt of lightning struck the ground between Town Hall, the Fire Department, and the Library.

Day-to-day operations were halted while a make-shift network was recreated to get all of the computers communicating with each other while an assessment was made to determine the severity of the storm.

No data or important information was lost, but Town Hall lost two computers, some networking equipment and access to two printers, while Public Works lost one computer from the power surge. The library had severe damage to computers also.

Now that hurricane season is officially upon us, it is very important to take the time to trim branches out of rights-of-way so that emergency vehicles can pass freely. It is also very important that you make sure you have a house number on your home which is visible from the road.
