The Town of Montverde has been hard at work acquiring a number of state grants to help improve the quality of life for its residents. Montverde has recently been awarded an \$18,075 grant from the state for its reforestation efforts. Over the next year the town is looking to plant a total of 65 trees (specifically Southern Magnolias, River Birch, Live Oaks and Slash Pines) in Truskett Park, along the trail and on 7th St. This grant will enhance the shade, beautification and help diversify the tree canopy between older and newer trees and optimize canopy health. Special thank you to Cherry Lake Tree Farm for helping the Town throughout the rigorous application process.

Montverde has also recently received an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant worth over \$140,00 which will be put toward improvements of the Town's energy efficiency of existing buildings and facilities.

Going Green Facts to Help Save Money and the Environment

- 84% of all household waste can be recycled.
- It takes 90% less energy to recycle aluminum cans than to make new ones.
- Target stores give a 5 cent discount for every reusable shopping bag you use.
- Compact fluorescent lights use approximately 75% less energy than traditional bulbs and last about 10 times longer than incandescent blubs.
- Buying post-consumer recycled paper for printing is found to be 10-20% cheaper than standard paper (depending on the brand).
- Remanufactured ink and toner cartridges cost about 15% less than standard brands and one returned cartridge keeps approximately 2.5 pounds of metal and plastic out of national landfills.
- $\bullet\,$ Purchasing Energy Star products can cut average power usage by about 75% over standard machines.
