TOWN HALL VISIT BY SHERIFF BORDERS

Lake County Sheriff Gary Borders was invited by Mayor Bennett to conduct a Town Hall-style meeting at the Montverde Auditorium last week. At the meeting, Sheriff Borders gave a presentation on the direction of the Sheriff's Department, and then fielded questions from residents.

Many residents expressed concern about the water trucks speeding through Town. Sheriff Borders explained that he had met with Mayor Bennett previously on the issue, and the Sheriff's Office was trying to increase patrol in Montverde to stop the speeding trucks. Sheriff Borders also mentioned that he would call Niagara Bottling Company to request that they drive their trucks a different route, instead of coming directly through Town. Since the meeting, many residents have reported to Town Hall staff that the problem has subsided.
