Bingo is catered (there is a charge for dinner) starting at 6 pm so come play, eat, have fun and win cash prizes.



- First Reading of Ordinance 2017-23 Expanding the Duties of the Planning and Zoning Board.
- Resolution 2017-26 Adopting the Preliminary Rate for the Fire Assessment.
- Resolution 2017-29 Supporting the Bridge over the Turnpike connecting Fosgate Road.
- First Reading of Ordinance 2017-25 Approving New Policies and Procedures for the Cemetery.
