The Town of Montverde is pleased to offer a new and improved process to pay your Utility Bill Online.

Go to <u>www.mymontverde.com</u> and click on the Water Faucet. This will bring you to a new page and in the lower left hand of the page, enter your WEB ID, which is located on your bill (Town Hall can provide your WEB ID if needed) on the next line enter the first four (4) letters of the Last Name of the Account Holder then hit Next. This will take you to your account page and you will be able to review your bill and make your payment. If you have saved the old payment site in your favorites, please delete it and save the new site.

## YARD DEBRIS PROCEDURES

Place all garden and yard trash - including tree and shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, and small tree branches - either in a 32 gallon trash can or commingled with garbage in a 96 gallon container, or in a suitable plastic bag. Shrubs, branches, limbs and palm fronds should not exceed four feet in length, and must be bundled and tied. No single item, can, bag or tied bundle should exceed 50 pounds in weight, other than the 96 gallon container. No more than four cans, bags or bundles may be set out for collection at one time.

**Excessive amounts or bulk yard trash items:** If more than four cans, bags or tied bundles of yard trash need to be set out, or piles of heavy logs and/or stacks of wood fencing, please contact **Waste Pro at 352-366-0352** to schedule a quote. Once payment is received, WastePro will schedule a rear loader collection vehicle or claw truck to collect excessive/ bulk yard trash material.

#### ADD A BUCK PROGRAM

Don't forget the "ADD A BUCK" program which helps our local food drive. If you are able you can add a "BUCK OR TWO" to your Water Bill when you make your payment, Town Hall will take all the extra "BUCKS" and send them to our local food bank account at Second Food Harvest.
