We have all done well with paying attention to what we need to do to stay safe and I hope this continues. Your Parks and Community Building are now open, and I am planning on opening the Town Hall to the public on or before June 15th. I would like to inform you about the projects that are in the works for our Town. First project is the street lights along the sidewalks in our Downtown area that will soon be installed. The lights will go from the corner of Porter Ave. and CR 455 to Kirkland Ave. and CR 455. This will add a great look and safety at night. We will also be replacing the street signs and stop signs along CR 455 with an upgraded brand and larger name plates...

I also need to tell you that Lake County has finished everything that was needed, and they have voted to start the Roundabout on the corner of CR 455 and Ridgewood Ave. in June. This project will take between four to six months at a cost of nearly one million dollars. The County feels this corner needs to get this roundabout installed mostly because of the future traffic it is expected to handle. There will be detours in place for vehicles and I hope this project goes smooth. I will keep you up to date as we move forward.
