ORDINANCE OF THE MONTH - TREES

Residents must secure a permit from the Town before removing any tree (alive or dead) with a diameter of four inches or greater, measured at four and one-half feet above existing grade. Removal without a permit is in violation of Sec. 12-3 of the Land Development Code and is subject to a fine of up to \$500. The cost of the permit is \$25 and \$ zero if the tree is designated to be dead.

Permits are also required before commencing any of the following; Erecting a Fence or Sign, Installing a pool, Driveway, Patio or Deck, Screened Enclosure, Shed or Canopy, Roof, Electrical, Building Addition or Demolition project. If in doubt, contact Town Hall first at (407) 469-2681.
