TAKE YOUR HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE TO ASTATULA

On Saturday March 4th, the Lake County Hazardous Waste Mobile Unit will be at the Town Park in Astatula from 9 am to 12 pm.

Signs will be posted. Only a 15 minute drive away, this is an Ideal opportunity to dispose of your

hazardous items that cannot be deposited in the regular trash.

Household Hazardous Waste Items include: Paint, Motor Oil, Gasoline, Propane Tanks, Antifreeze, Car Batteries, Household Batteries (including rechargeable). Lawn Chemicals, Pesticides, Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Aerosol Cans and Pool Chemicals.

NEXT COUNCIL MEETINGS AND WORKSHOPS

There will be a Council Workshop on Tuesday March 7, at 6:30 pm to discuss the preparation of the Town's Master Sidewalk Plan.

Following the Workshop at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, the Local Planning Agency (LPA) will hold a public hearing in the Town Hall Auditorium to make a recommendation to Town Council concerning the adoption of Ordinance Nos. 2017-14, 2017-15, and 2017-16, a change to the Town's Land Development Code (LDC) and Comprehensive Plan.

At 7:15 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, the Town Council will hold a public hearing at the Town Hall Auditorium to consider the recommendation of the LPA and transmittal of Ordinance Nos. 2017-15 and 2017-16 and approval, approval with conditions, or denial of Ordinance No. 2017-14 (revisions to LDC) to the Department of Economic Opportunity.

The next Regular Council meeting will be on Tuesday March 14, 2017 at 7:00 pm. Key issues for discussion are:

Rezoning of Properties owned by Montverde Academy from Residential to Institutional.

Residents are encouraged to attend these meetings; public comment is permitted at every meeting. This month meatloaf, sides and salad will be served in the Mayors office prior to the meeting starting at 5:30 pm.
