NEWS FROM MAYOR JOE

Hello, here is an update on a few topics happening in your Town. The Town is in the process of building the NEW Public Works building behind the baseball field, stop by and take a look during March. We have had in the past four different small buildings that have been used to store our Public Works equipment. Soon we will be able to have all of our equipment in one place which will open up three buildings for a new adventure. One of the three buildings is where the Deputy Sheriff has a small office in our downtown. We will be looking for ideas for that building if anyone can come up with one please call me. We have completed the new curbing and drain on the corner of 8th street and Neal Drive which was very much in need of attention. Our Team has been working on many buildings and structure's since Hurricane Irma and also many hours into submitting everything to FEMA and our insurance company. After many meetings with our insurance company and FEMA it looks like we will finally be getting paid (Hopefully). On the issue with water in the Four Lakes Area, we spent many days pumping the south of Ridgewood water down to follow the canal to Lake Apopka. After many days of pumping we found what we believe to be the root cause to this back up and brought it to the County's attention. The County is reviewing everything now and I will have their solution very soon and at that time I will update everyone. Pillar Homes is now in the process of engineering the road behind Morning side which is Lakemont Ave that goes to Ridgewood. When that is completed I expect them to move forward with building homes on Lakemont Ave. BlackEast property owners have recently been in touch with me to discuss the concerns of a New home builder they are talking with. I also expect this property owner to move forward soon with this project and I will keep everyone up to date. The roundabout and the paving of Ridgewood is moving forward but will be two separate times for the construction. After talking with the County I would expect to see the Roundabout start this summer, and then Ridgewood later in the year. Please come to the Council Meetings if you can. As always we serve dinner starting at 5:30 pm in the Mayor's office. ****NOTICE** EXCHANGE OF GARBAGE CART & RECYCLE BIN **NOTICE****

Effective immediately, a customer shall be allowed to exchange their garbage cart or recycling bin anytime if damaged. The customer will call **Waste Pro Customer Service at 352-366-0352** and request an exchange due to a damaged cart or bin. There is no charge for exchanging a damaged garbage cart or recycle bin. If the customer requests an exchange of a dirty cart or bin for a clean cart or bin, the customer will pay Waste Pro \$40.00 prior to delivery. Waste Pro shall deliver carts or bins within five (5) business days after the customer requests the exchange.

YARD DEBRIS PROCEDURES

Place all garden and yard trash, includes tree & shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, & small branches either in a 32 gal trash can, commingled w/ garbage in the 96 gal container, or in a plastic bag. Shrubs, branches, limbs & palm fronds should not exceed 4 ft in length & must be bundled/tied. No single item can exceed 50 lbs. No more than 4 cans, bags or bundles may be set out for collection at one time. **Excessive amounts or bulk yard trash items:** If more than four cans, bags or tied bundles of yard trash need to be set out, or piles of heavy logs and/or stacks of wood fencing, please contact Waste Pro at **352-366-0352** to schedule a quote. Once payment is received, Waste Pro will schedule the the collection of excessive/bulk yard trash material.
