

# Montverde Idol

# New Contract For Garbage Service

Over the past few months, I have had meetings with the County regarding their garbage collection. The County has recently secured contracts with three vendors for garbage collection. In meeting with them, I discovered that the rate charged to the County by Waste Pro was less than the rate that Waste Pro charges the Town. I met with Waste Pro and requested a rate decrease, so that the Town's rate is comparable to the County's rate. I am happy to report that after several meetings with Waste Pro, they have agreed to lower their rates. The new contract should go before Council for approval at the May 13 meeting. The decreased rates should equal about \$10 per household per year.

#### **Recreational Trail**

The Recreational Trail connecting Kirk Park to Truskett Park is nearly complete. Funded by a State grant, the Trail should be open for public use within the next two weeks. We are also applying for a second State grant to extend the current trail along County Road 455 all the way to Fosgate Road.

### **Speeding Trucks in Town**

I have received several calls/emails from residents concerned about the large trucks speeding through Town. I have met with our Town deputy, and she has agreed to increase her patrol along CR 455 to slow these trucks down. Also, I have spoken with the County Public Works Director, and we are working on a solution to divert these trucks from traveling along CR 455. I will keep you updated on the situation.
