ORDINANCE OF THE MONTH—ANIMALS

The Town's code of ordinances states that it is unlawful for any animal to run at large or for any owner to permit or allow the persons animal to run at large within the municipality. Dogs can be intimidating, particularly to Children. Please ensure that your pets are kept on a leash and pick up after them at all times.

Permits are required before commencing any of the following; Removing any Tree (dead or alive), Erecting a Fence or Sign, Installing a Pool, Driveway, Patio or Deck, Screened Enclosure, Shed or Canopy, Roof, Electrical, Building Addition or Demolition project. Stiff penalties can be imposed for non-compliance. If in doubt, contact Town Hall first at (407) 469-2681.
