There were hundreds of attendees participating in this action packed event. On a different topic, your Public Works Department is in the process of replacing Lowery Road and the water pipes throughout. They are also installing tanks in the ground that will filter the storm water in this area before it goes into Lake Florence. In the Four Lakes area, your Public Works Department is monitoring the level of the water 7 days a week. They also had a camera and power wash system go through all the pipes between the lakes to ensure the water was not blocked in anyway. The water is still at its high water mark but is flowing correctly as new water enters the lakes. The Town is also having meetings with Montverde Academy and discussing ways to help the flow of traffic. MVA has put a lot of effort into addressing this by having their High School students get dropped off and picked up on 9<sup>th</sup> street and by having their Middle school students dropped and picked up on Porter Ave instead of CR 455. ## EXCHANGE OF GARBAGE CART/RECYCLING BIN

Effective immediately, a customer shall be allowed to exchange their garbage cart or recycling bin anytime if damaged. The customer will call **Waste Pro Customer Service at 352-366-0352** and request an exchange due to a damaged cart or bin. There is no charge for exchanging a damaged garbage cart or recycle bin. If the customer requests an exchange of a dirty cart or bin for a clean cart or bin, the customer will pay Waste Pro \$40.00 prior to delivery. Waste Pro shall deliver carts or bins within five (5) business days after the customer requests the exchange.



#### YARD DEBRIS PROCEDURES

Place all garden and yard trash, includes tree & shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, & small branches either in a 32 gal trash can, commingled w/ garbage in the 96 gal container, or in a plastic bag. Shrubs, branches, limbs & palm fronds should not exceed 4 ft in length & must be bundled/tied. No single item can exceed 50 lbs. No more than 4 cans, bags or bundles may be set out for collection at one time. **Excessive amounts or bulk yard trash items:** If more than four cans, bags or tied bundles of yard trash need to be set out, or piles of heavy logs and/or stacks of wood fencing, please contact Waste Pro at **352-366-0352** to schedule a quote. Once payment is received, Waste Pro will schedule the the collection of excessive/bulk yard trash material.
