Mayor's Message

Hello, I hope this message finds you and your family in good health and spirits.

I'm excited to share that in February, we held the groundbreaking event for the new Regional Fire/EMS station in Montverde. The event was a success, with County Commissioners, the County Manager and team, Fire/EMS teams, the Montverde Town Council and team, and many residents in attendance. This long-awaited project will be a significant asset to our community, and we anticipate it will be completed and operational by the end of this year. Let's watch it grow!

On another note, Councilman Jim Ley has resigned from his position on the Town Council. I would like to extend my sincere thanks to Jim for his dedicated service over the past nine years. His contributions have played a major role in the numerous successes and accomplishments we've achieved.

With Jim's resignation, the position is now vacant. If you are interested in being considered for the role, please submit your application by 4:00 PM on March 12th. While it's not required, I recommend completing the application form available on the Town's website (<u>mymontverde.com</u>) or at the Town Hall. Applicants must be registered voters who have lived in Montverde for at least 12 months. For more information, please contact Sandy Johnson, Town Clerk, at 407-469-2681.

Regarding the 111-acre development project next to the boat ramp on Lake Apopka, we continued discussions at the February Town Council meeting. The developer has requested a Planned Unit Development (PUD) designation, which would allow for more flexibility in negotiations on aspects like design, lot width, and landscaping. Several residents attended to voice their concerns, and after a lengthy discussion, I made a motion to deny the PUD request. The vote was 3-2 in favor of the denial. The developer will return to a future meeting for a second vote. Please stay informed by checking upcoming Town Council agendas if you'd like to stay involved in shaping Montverde future.

Finally, I'm pleased to update you on the \$19.8 million grant we secured. After deciding not to move forward with the sewer system, we successfully redirected the grant toward a Storm Water project. This will allow us to improve our drainage systems, retention areas, and water filtration processes, ensuring that stormwater does not pollute our lakes. This is another important win for Montverde, and I look forward to seeing it come to fruition.

Hello and Happy Spring,

Many exciting projects around town have started or will be started very shortly. Montverde is in a wonderful position to complete nearly all these projects utilizing grants rather than our general budget. The library's progress is moving at an incredible pace. The contractors are now focused on interior designs, such as lighting and flooring. We are anticipating opening the doors in the mid to late summer of this year. Lakeside Drive will have some exciting improvements starting in the next couple of months. Contractors will start on a \$750,000 stormwater project and road improvements from 7th Street to 3rd Street. Finally, the butterfly garden is scheduled to start construction in March, anticipating completion by the end of May.
