Mayor's Message

Hello, I hope this message finds you well and safe. During our June Council meeting, we discussed and approved an increase in the Town's impact fees for new construction. The increased fees are necessary to offset the rising costs of infrastructure and services that come with new construction. Many of these fees have not been updated in over seven years, while the cost of materials and services has significantly increased during that time. Please keep in mind, impact fees can only be used to address issues directly caused by new construction.

We also held the first reading of a proposed amendment to the Town Charter. This amendment would create a new section requiring a supermajority vote (4 out of 5 Council members) for any Comprehensive Plan Amendment that seeks to increase the allowable housing density within Montverde's town limits. In practical terms, if a landowner wanted to build more than two homes per acre, this new rule would make it significantly more challenging unless there is strong Council support. This proposed amendment is scheduled to go before the voters on November 4, 2025, during the regular election.

Additionally, Lake County is currently hosting meetings to address countywide growth and how best to manage it. I've been attending these meetings along with our Town Manager, and I encourage you to participate if you're able. If you can't attend in person, the meetings are available for viewing on the Lake County website at your convenience.

With Phase 2 almost complete, I want to extend a warm welcome to all of our new residents in Willow Ridge! It's been a pleasure meeting many of you, and I look forward to seeing more new faces at our Town meetings and events. Please join me in giving them a heartfelt WELCOME TO MONTVERDE.

As always, we invite everyone to attend our monthly Town Council meetings, held on the second Tuesday of each month. We serve dinner at 5:30 PM, and the meeting begins at 7:00 PM. Additional meetings and workshops are scheduled as needed, so please check the Town website for updates.
