I hope everyone is doing well and getting ready for summer. The town has been busy working on several capital projects.

Town Manager's Message

I have had a lot of questions about the ribbons or paint on the trees in town. The trees marked by the surveyors are for reference only and does not mean the tree will be removed. The surveyors are locating the underground utilities, right of way, and easements throughout town. As part of the survey, they located the trees that may be near some of these utilities. The information is used as a reference on the final survey map that will be provided to the town.

We have broken ground on the new stage located in Kirk Park. The footing is poured, and the stem walls are constructed. The library is moving forward as well. The Footing has been poured, the stem wall has been constructed, and backfill will be happening soon. There is a lot of underground work to be done on both projects so the final wall can go up.

The town's Visioning Committee is exploring new sign options for the town entrance signs and considering ideas for fitness stations along the town trails. I appreciate their work and dedication to improving Montverde's quality and livability.

I encourage you to attend the town council meetings and pay attention to the Lake County Commission meetings. If all goes as planned, the Montverde Council meetings will start airing as soon as May on South Lake TV. Once we go live, there will also be a link to access meetings on our website as soon as possible.
