I would like to mention this pass October 2023 made three years that we have had our new government in place with a full time Town Manager. I feel this new way of managing the Town has been an overall positive experience. Having a full-time employee on staff to manage the dayto-day operations has been much more productive with handling different items timelier then in the pass. I feel our Townhall Team is improving operations and getting the Town more benefits from both the County and State opportunities.

I have an update on the topic of golf carts being driven in Town Limits. Recently the state passed a new Statute. It is now illegal for anyone under 18 years of age to drive a golf cart on any road without a valid learner's driver licenses or valid driver's License.

Awhile back Covid put an end to "The Friends of Montverde" group that would meet once a month. I would like to get this program back up and operating. If you would like to be a part of this monthly group that would meet and discuss things like activities for our older folks, or even our younger crowd and help plan and execute these activities and meetings each month, please give me a call during November. I will see how much interest there is for getting this group back together.

Update on our Regional Fire Department that Lake County had purchased three acres of land from the Town. The property is next to the corner of RT455 and Fosgate. This project was delayed but is now on the way, and you should start to see activity with the building being built soon. This of course will eventually leave our old Fire station empty. I would like to hear from our residents what they would think the Town Council should do with this over 5,000 square foot building so we can start to make plans.
