Hello,

Hard to believe summer is going to be winding down soon and fall is around the corner. With the end of summer, school is back in session. Please be patient and vigilant in the school and downtown areas. Parents are learning the new drop off routines and kids are walking the sidewalks and crossing the streets on 455. Montverde Academy is working hard to try to keep traffic moving during the drop-off hours, while ensuring safety for the school kids. Please be aware as we welcome the start of school.
