Time changes November 1st, 2009. We will all be setting our clocks back one hour on Nov. 1 with the return of Eastern Standard Time, which means it is also time to reduce the amount of time which you will be watering you lawn and landscaping to no more than once per week. Please keep in mind that with the time changes also comes seasonal change in the watering restrictions. Lawns need much less watering in the winter months due to dormancy. Homes with addresses that end in an odd number or have no address may water only on Saturdays, and homes with address ending in an even number may water only on Sundays. Nonresidential irrigation is allowed on Tuesdays.
