Please remember to set your irrigation schedule in accordance with the Town's irrigation schedule. The schedule is set in place as a proactive measure to help conserve the Town's valuable water resources.

Residential Irrigation - odd numbered addresses/no addresses water on Saturday only, not between 10:00 a.m. — 4:00 p.m. and this includes private wells.

Residential Irrigation — even numbered addressed/no address water on Sunday only, not between 10:00 a.m. — 4:00 p.m. and this includes private wells.
