The Town of Montverde met for a Local Planning Agency session on Tuesday, October 14, 2014 at 6:45 PM in the Town Hall Auditorium.

Mayor Bennett called the meeting to order at 6:45 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was performed, and it was determined that a quorum was present.

Town Planning Consultant Sean Parks stated that this Economic Prosperity Element of the Comprehensive Plan has been worked on for several months now. The vote today is to transmit the Element to the State Department of Economic Opportunity. He explained that the final version of the Element incorporated the changes requested by Council at the last LPA meeting.

Glenn Burns stated that he saw of couple of things that needed to be changed. In Section 1-1.4.4, it discusses that the Town shall promote several industries, and he stated that he thought Council recommended adding Heritage Tourism to the list. Sean Parks stated that he could add the wording change. Glenn Burns also stated that in Section 3, "by-way" should be one word (byway). Sean Parks confirmed that he would make those changes.

Mayor Bennett explained that the LPA process involves LPA members voting to recommend approval to transmit the Economic Prosperity Element to Councilmen. The five members of Council are also the five members of the LPA.

Anita Geraci-Carver read the Ordinance in title only. Mayor Bennett explained that this is an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan.

Mayor Bennett opened the floor for public comment. Seeing none, he closed public comment.
