OCTOBER IS FIRE PROTECTION MONTH

At this time of year, remember to change the batteries in the smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in your home. Practice exit drills with your children and family and have a predetermined meeting place away from the building to meet at in the event of a fire in your home.

If you do have a fire, do not try to put it out yourself. Fire doubles in size every 18 seconds. Exit the building staying low to the floor, crawl to the nearest exit and go to your meeting place. Call 911.
