FY 2017 BUDGET APPROVED

The final budget for Fiscal Year 2017 was presented to Council on September 21, 2016. Mayor Joe Wynkoop presented the budget for next year reflecting total General Fund revenues of \$1,039,500 and total General Fund expenditures of \$1,004,725. This means that \$34,775 will be added to the Town's Reserves (savings) and is available for any necessary capital improvement projects.

The budget was presented with a property tax rate of 2.83 mils. This property tax rate has stayed the same since 2007. The Town has been able to accomplish a lot of capital improvements without raising the tax rate.
