NEWS FROM MAYOR JOE

Hello, I hope you and your family are doing well. Here are a few items that I would like to keep everyone up to date on. On this years ballet in November there will only be the Charter change from a Strong Mayor Government to a Town Manager/Council Mayor Government. I will be sending out more information on this topic soon so you will be able to read and compare the two forms of government to be able to make an informed decision. At this time feel free to call if you would like me to explain it to you personally (407-496-1673) or you can go to the Towns web site at <u>Mymontverde.com</u> and there is a 2 minute video on the front page you can watch. We will also be having another Charter Change Meeting on Oct 17th @ 6:30 p.m. in Townhall, everyone is welcome to come and discuss this topic.

On September 9th we had our first 2019-2020 Budget Hearing discussion and on September 10th we had our monthly Council meeting and First reading of Ordinance 2019-025 on adopting the Florida Building Code. Then Resolution 2019-016 for the Superfund site of Tower Chemical and the Resolution 2019-024 for the transfer of \$250,000 to the Water Fund from the general fund to repay the Water Fund for the purchase of the Stecher Property that was bought many years back. The Council also approved the Minor Site Plan Application and Variance Application submitted from Montverde Academy for the new Middle School. The Tiley Minor Subdivision Application and the Interlocal Agreement with Lake County regarding CR 455 and Ridgewood roundabout where also discussed. The Council also discussed the Drainage and Easement agreement with Lake County concerning the CR455 and Ridgewood Round about. Lastly the Council approved the Statutory Warranty Deed with Lake County for the Roundabout Project.

The next meeting was September 12th on Resolution 2019-27 adopting the Tentative Leving of Ad Valorem Taxes for Fiscal year 2019-2020. Also Resolution 2019-028 adopting Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. September 12th we had our second Town Charter Change from a Strong Mayor to a Council Manager Government Public Meeting. Then on September 26th the Council had our Final Budget Resolution 2019-029. This is most everything the Townhall moved forward in September.

Don't forget on Oct 31st we will have our WORLD FAMOUS TRUNK OR TREAT event at Kirk Park starting at 5:30 p.m. This is a great time that I personally enjoy with DJ Don playing music and giving out prizes for many categories and FREE Ritter Ice Cream. Normally we have around 30 vehicles that attend and hand out candies and goodies to the kids.

Then the next day on Friday at 5pm November 1st and November 2nd we will start our 40th MONTVERDE DAY. This is our main event for the year and we look forward to seeing everyone there.

Please try to attend your monthly Council Meetings that are the second Tuesday of every month. Dinner is served to everyone starting at 5:30pm in the Mayors office and the meeting starts at 7pm.
