I hope you and your family are doing well and staying safe.

Good news from our Fire Department, we were scheduled to have an ambulance based at Montverde's fire station in late 2022. It was announced at our September Council meeting by the Battalion Chief of Lake County Fire Department that they have stationed an ambulance in Montverde seven days a week from 9am to 9pm. This has been one of your Council's main initiatives over the pass three years and it is great to see it all coming together quicker then originally planned. The Ambulance will be 24/7 in the near future.

Other good news is the Publix on Hancock road is now open and this will help our Montverde residents a lot when the Turnpike bridge for the Publix on Highway 50 closes soon for 14 months.

I recently sat with the City Manager of Groveland and he informed me that Groveland will soon be adding another NEW 1 million square foot of commercial space for two new businesses. Amazon and Kroger's are already operating in Groveland, with the new building and adding 5,000 new jobs in our area.
