

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-197**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MONTVERDE, FLORIDA AMENDING THE 2024-2025 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET PURSUANT TO SECTION 5.05 OF THE TOWN CHARTER TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM GENERAL FUND REVENUES TO VARIOUS GENERAL FUND DEPARTMENTS FOR INCREASED EXPENDITURES IN THE PERMITTING DEPARTMENT; AND GARBAGE/SOLID WASTE SERVICES FEES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget of the Town of Montverde was adopted on September 20, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council had an increase in permit fees paid by developers which has resulted in the need to increase the Permitting Fund account and decrease the General Fund Balance to cover the cost of contractual services for the increase in housing permits issued, therefore an amendment is required for FY 24-25 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council had an increase in user fees paid for garbage/solid waste services resulting from an increase in the number of garbage/solid waste accounts opened and a CPI adjustment to the contractual services contract which has resulted in the need to increase Garbage/Solid Waste Services Fund account and decrease the General Fund Balance to cover the cost of contractual services for the increased accounts and CPI adjustment, therefore an amendment is required for FY 24-25 Budget and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to amend the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year budget to transfer funds as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MONTVERDE, FLORIDA:


Section 1. The 2024-2025 budget adopted on September 18, 2024, is amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
