<u>Challenges with other sites in town</u>

- Proximity to wetlands and low-lying areas with high groundwater
- Size of land needed for full build out
- Geography and topography of sites caused mounding with groundwater coming to the surface in surrounding lower-lying properties.
- Meeting DEP Setback requirements from landowners, wetlands, and wells

Site Requirements

- Land Size adequate to handle Rapid Infiltration Basins (RIBS)
- Distance from wetlands to allow proper function RIB's
- Water table / Geography for proper infiltration from RIBS
- DEP Requirements for water effluent Water quality
- Proximity to potential sewer hookups and maximizing potential hooks ups to allow compliance with BMAP Regulations
