



A Tropical Storm Warning and Flood Watch are in effect for Lake County, including the Town of Montverde. Lake County and the Town of Montverde has declared a local emergency.

- Tropical Storm Nicole is anticipated to make landfall on the Southeastern Coast of Florida as a Category 1 Hurricane in the early afternoon of Wednesday, November 9.
- Expected Impacts – Tropical wind and flooding rain hazards pose the greatest threat to our area. **Expected peak winds are 40-55 mph with 75 mph gusts. Total rainfall of 3-8” is expected for Lake County and Montverde.**

Wind Onset Timing - Wednesday at 1800 (+/- 2 hours)

Wind Departure Timing – to Thursday at 2000 (+/- 2 hours)

Town Hall will be closed on Thursday November 10th from 7:00 am until 1:00 p.m. If weather conditions have not improved, Town Hall will be closed for rest of the day and reopen on Monday November 14th.

Residents should prepare their property for high winds

- Secure trashcans.
- Secure all outside furniture and loose items.
- Be prepared for loss of power and have an alternative light source.
- Check your emergency kit.
- Monitor local weather conditions and forecast.
- If you have an emergency, please call 911.
- The Lake County Emergency Management Office has been activated. The Citizens Information Line (CIL) is conducting 24-hour operations. The CIL can be reached at 352-253-9999.
