SIGN UP FOR BANK DRAFT FOR YOUR MONTHLY UTILITY BILL

The Town offers the convenience of Bank Draft for your monthly Utility Bill. Please provide Town Hall the signed consent form & a void check for the Bank Draft option. The Consent Form can be found on the Town's Website: www.mymontverde.com or Town Hall can email it to you or you can pick the form up at Town Hall.

EXCHANGE GARBAGE CART/RECYCLING BIN

A customer shall be allowed to exchange their garbage cart or recycling bin anytime if damaged. The customer will call **Waste Pro Customer Service at 352-366-0352** and request an exchange due to a damaged cart or bin. There is no charge for an exchange of a damaged cart or recycle bin. If the customer requests an exchange of a dirty cart or bin for a clean cart or bin, the customer will pay Waste Pro \$40.00 prior to delivery. Waste Pro shall deliver carts or bins within five (5) business days after the customer requests the exchange.

YARD DEBRIS PROCEDURES

Place all garden and yard trash, includes tree & shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, & small branches either in a 32 gal trash can, commingled w/ garbage in the 96 gal container, or in a plastic bag. Shrubs, branches, limbs & palm fronds should not to exceed 4 ft in length & must be bundled/ tied. No single item can exceed 50 lbs. No more than 4 cans, bags or bundles may be set out for collection at one time. Excessive amounts or bulk yard trash items: If more than four cans, bags or tied bundles of yard trash need to be set out, or piles of heavy logs and/or stacks of wood fencing, please contact Waste Pro at 352-366-0352 to schedule a quote. Once payment is received, Waste Pro will schedule the the collection of excessive/ bulk yard trash material.
