Hello, I hope you and your family had a wonderful Christmas and Holiday. I have had folks ask me about certain topics, so I thought I would communicate back to everyone using the news letter on the topics. On the progress of the roundabout going in at County Road 455 and Ridgewood. After a few delays in June and July the County and Town together decided to hold off on moving this forward till May. This was delayed mostly because of the Traffic we have twice a day while Montverde Academy is in secession. The County will be ready to start this project and complete it during the school summer break. On the topic of the update on our water system and installing a new water tank to handle the increase going forward. We have been working with our engineering firm and another company to come up with what is needed now and what will be needed in the future. We have broken this down into three phases and this will be held during a January Town Council Work Session.

We have been putting an effort into keeping our Web Site up to date and making it easy for everyone to use. An example of this is our recently implemented Permitting process. There will be a new link on our front page that will make it easier for everyone to get to the permitting information and forms soon.
